North American Wood Pellet Exports up 70 percent 3rd Qtr 2012

February 7th, 2013 in News Biomass Magazine By: Nancy Bean Foster Wood pellet exports in North America were up 70 percent in the third quarter of 2012, compared to the third quarter of 2011, according to a new report by the North American Wood Fiber Review. That is largely in part because of increased pellet production in the southern U.S. and British Columbia. Production reached a new record of 860,000 tons during that time, according to the report. The growth is expected to continue as a result of numerous plans for adding capacity, particularly in the U.S. South. This year, numerous plans for new pellet plants have been announced, including a \$60 million, 440,000-ton plant by General Biofuels and a 330,000 metric ton-plant by Enova Energy Group.
